There are only 2 marked headstones visible, and many field stones. An earlier estimate of the field stones, which ^{may} probably belong to slaves, was 50 but their number is not now visible. The top section of what was a 5 foot tall headstone ^{for Washington Waters} has been knocked from the 3 section base, probably by cattle or horses. The marked headstones are readable. There is no fence separating the cemetery from the horse pasture. There are no paths or roads See over.

WATERS CEMETERY

This cemetery is located behind an old home on Blunt Rd. in the Goshen area. The house is now owned by the Burton family. The cemetery is very overgrown and some stones have probably disappeared. There was a huge walnut tree, surrounded by about 50 unmarked stones probably belonging to slaves.

M. Waters, died August 13, 1864 in the 42nd year of her age. On bottom of stone: "He that believeth in me though he were dead, yet shall he live, and he who believeth in me shall never die."

A. White, died in 1862, aged ~~at~~ 2 months

Steven White died in 1863, aged 2 yrs. and 9 mos.

Elisha Williams, died February 1862, aged 48 yrs.

Joffe Cooke, infant of Nathan and Harriet A. Cooke
Died February 21, 1876, aged 1 yr. 5 mos. 19 das.
on the bottom of this stone: "Suffer little children who come unto me and forbid them not."

A large marker, about 5 ft. tall with four sides:

Dr. Washington Waters, died February 24, 1882 in the 78th year of his age.

Ann Waters, died November 4, 1844 in the 45th year of her age.
