

Within a short while the number of interments in Beechment cemetery will be increased by the addition of all the remains that now lie in the old Presbyterian cemetery. Beechment is located on the Conduit road, about a mile and a quarter above the Cabin John bridge, the location being selected so as to preclude all possibility of any change from the original pur-The cemetery contains about 211 acres, and is traversed its entire length by a small stream called Rock run, which will be used for beautifying the new cemetery with lakes and waterfalls.

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


