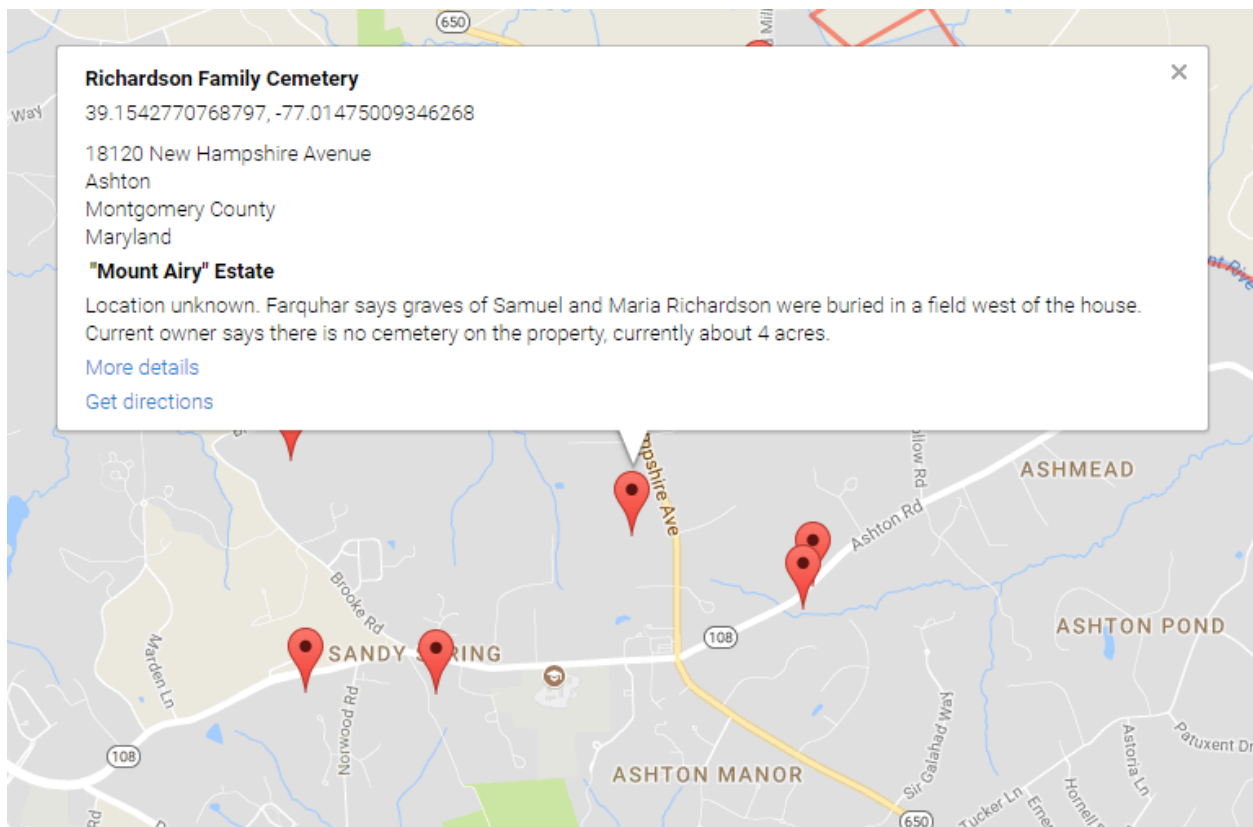

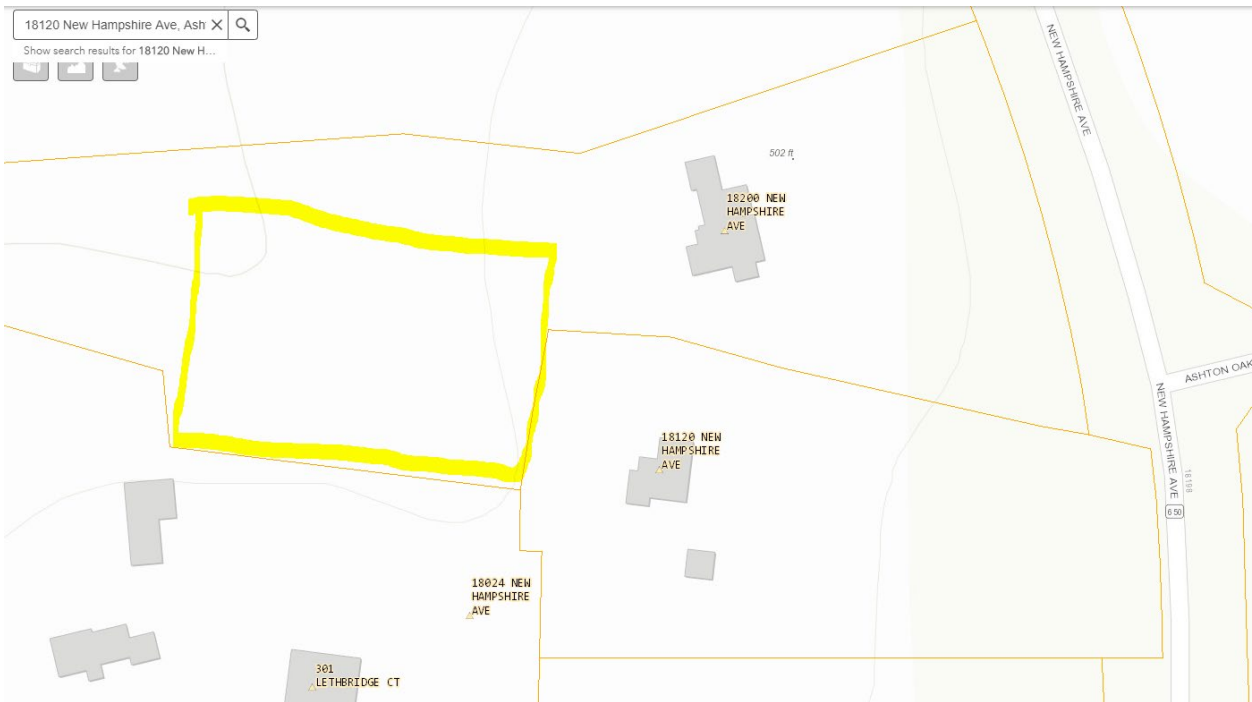
Suggestions for follow-up:
