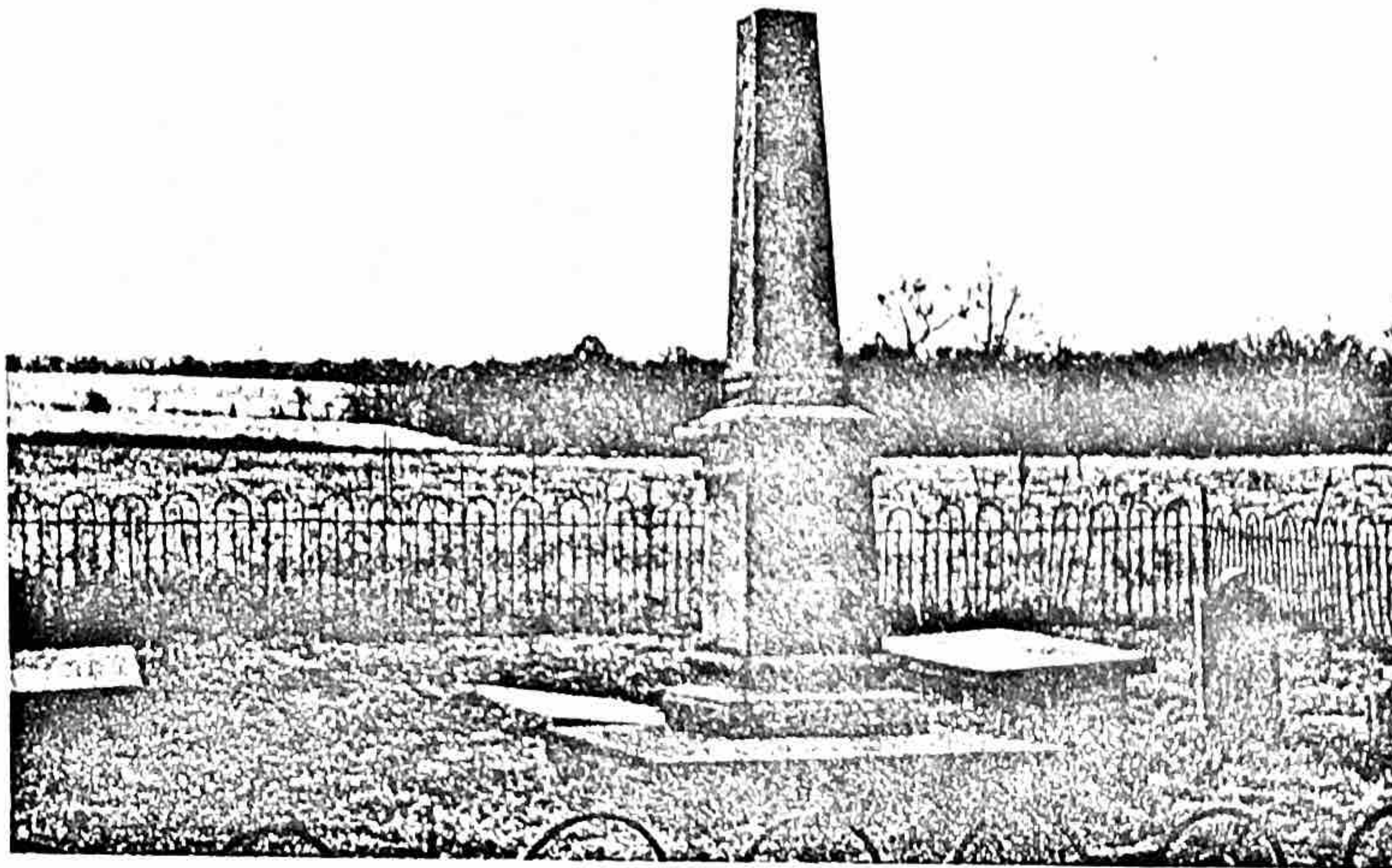

PETER FAMILY CEMETERY ON MONTEVIDEO

Location: Near Seneca, on tract of land called *Montevideo*. [A.D.C. Map: Montgomery, page 29, grid coordinates D-1.] Condition of cemetery: unknown, on property of Martha Custis Peter, descendant of George Washington's wife. Inactive cemetery. Earliest known death: 1821. Most recent death: 1854. Famous person interred: John Parke Custis Peter. Location of transcribed records: Montgomery County Historical Society Library, 42 West Middle Lane, Rockville, Maryland 20850. Author: Roger Brooke Farquhar. Title: *Old Homes and History of Montgomery County, Maryland*, pages 219-220. Publisher: American History Research Associates, Brookeville, MD, 1952. Comments: At least 5 marked graves, appears to be an iron fence enclosed.
