Unfortunately, this magnificent house was destroyed before the fieldwork for the present survey began. According to the Maryland Historical Trust surveyors, this was a superb, stone Georgian house of elegant design and rich carved panelling. Photographs taken several years ago show a lower, two-story log section attached to the east end of the house. The house (in good structural condition) was pushed down by Kettler Bros. in the summer of 1972, and nothing has been built since in its place.
