There is a large variety of stones but most are ^{tablets} upright with husband and wife names. The stones in the newest section are ground level granite. The oldest stones are faded and not easily readable. There is a monument to 17 unknown Confederate soldiers at the southwest corner of the cemetery. The landscaping is large old trees and large shrub bushes. The cemetery is bordered on the west by Georgia Avenue, on the east by the church, the south by Grace Church Road and on the north by the church offices. There is no fencing.
