The cemetery is on the north side of the church and extends past the church and behind the church. The markers behind the church are mostly 19th century stones.

The markers are mostly upright stones. There are many obelisk stones and the older stones are moss covered or blackened by age. The older stones appear to be sandstone, and the later ones are granite or marble.

The cemetery is fenced on the north and east sides by a chain link fence. The west side and south side to about the middle of the church is fenced by a single chain. There is no fence on the south side for the section behind the church.

*The cemetery is mowed & has a few evergreen trees.*
