Name: Moses Hall, Morningstar Tabernacle #88 Ancient Order of Brothers and Sisters, Sons and Daughters of Moses Cemetery

Note: it is separate from the church and only members of this fraternal organization and their family could be buried at the cemetery

Cemetery Association: African American Fraternal organization

Negative Impacts: It has since been cleaned and cleared and community members are working on a preservation plan

Burials: 50 or more

Dates Range: 1912 -1975

Description: There are several grave markers all lined up in rows (the markers are rocks from the local quarry). In addition there are three concrete markers (no writing), one large headstone (with writing) and three headstones in the ground (writing). There is one plot with a low white garden fencing.

Comments: The cemetery is located on the Moses Hall property. Moses Hall burned down in the early 1960's. Moses Hall housed the African American school after it moved out of Gibson Grove A.M.E. Zion church. There are some graves located beyond the fence area bordering the beltway.
