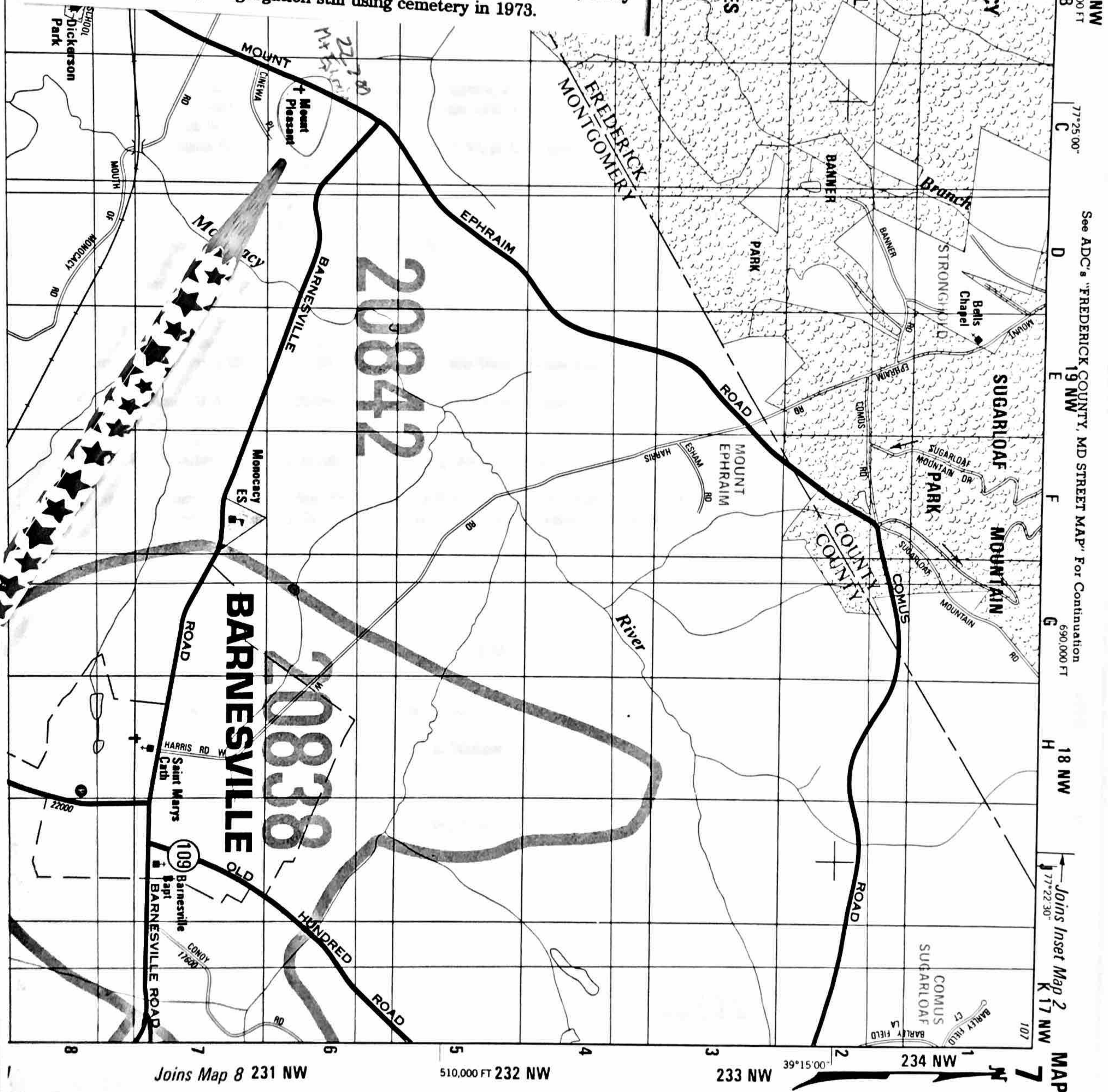

 still in use in 1937, stones broken and missing. Inactive cemetery. Most  
 recent death: 1887, Earliest known death: 1918. Veterans interred: Civil  
 War. In 1937, 4 record volumes, 1885-1937, at M.E. South Clarksburg  
 parsonage. Date transcribed: 1983. Location of transcribed records:  
 Montgomery County Historical Society Library, 42 West Middle Lane,  
 Rockville, Maryland 20850. Comments: Over 48 marked graves, many  
 graves unmarked, congregation still using cemetery in 1973.
