These are the people my mother said that she knew were buried in the Gartrell family graveyard. Francis Gartrell Jr. is the forefather of most of the Md. Gartrells. He bought 200 acres of land on the Pawtuxant River from John Dorsey and later added an additional 1300 acres. He married a Miss Hobbs who died without children, then remarried Jane Perry who produced 11 children. I am sure other Gartrells were buried in the graveyard also.

Dorcus Gartrell, b. 1724 d. abt 1784 - a daughter of Francis, Sr. married a sea captain named Matthew Pigman and they had a son named Nathan and he or some of his decendants are said to be buried in the family graveyard.

Charles Arthur Gartrell - (my grandfather - was moved to St. John's Cemetery in 1936)

All the grandfathers lived on the original Gartrell property. The Frank Hawkins house on the Denit property was built by French Gartrell, brother of Charles Arthur. I have been trying to call a cousin to verify that he too was probably buried there along with his wife. Margaret Townsend but haven't been able to reach her. She had been very vocal about the Denit developers recognizing the Gartrell graveyard, Charles Gartrell, son of Lucius Gartrell, my dad's brother, was also quite involved in trying to get something. My cousin was told they would put a bench close to the original cemetery with Gartrell Family Cemetery. There was also a slave graveyard back of Ms. Dennit's house according to family history.

Nothing has ever been done re-a memorial or recognition of graveyards that were on Gartrell land.
