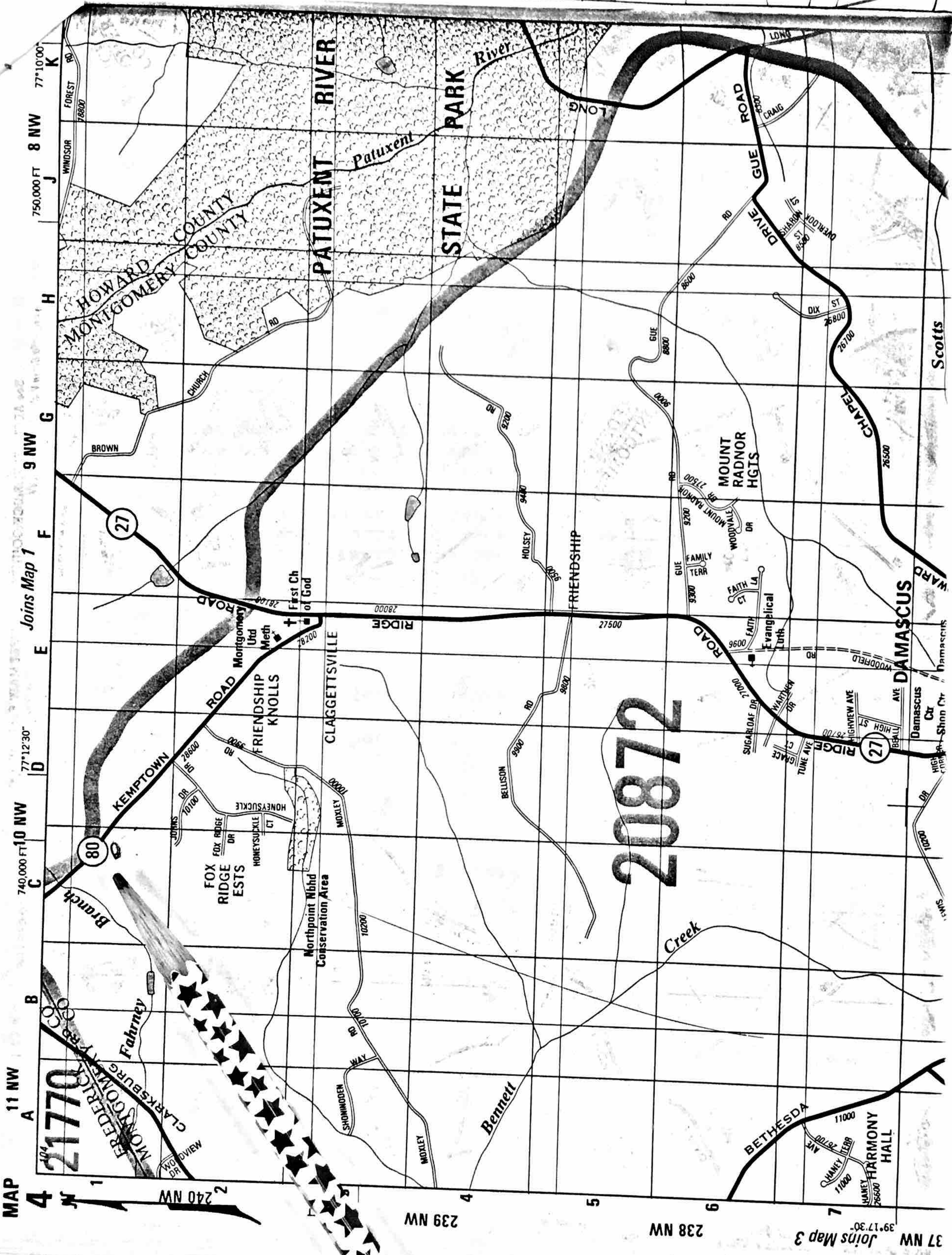

Dear Friends:

An apparent new feature on the landscape this winter in Montgomery County between Kemptown and Claggettville is a group of tombstones leaning against a stump in a plowed field. I had not noted the stones until a few weeks ago, so I am assuming that they had been lying down and/or covered with brush and when the field was plowed recently they were picked up and moved so that the plowed area could be expanded over a cemetery.

Perhaps someone in your organization or a geneological society will want to record the stones if they have not already been recorded.

The stones are about 200 feet south of Rt. 80 and very obvious as you drive by, especially when headed southeast from Kemptown. They are in an open field just east of Fahrney Branch. See enclosed map.

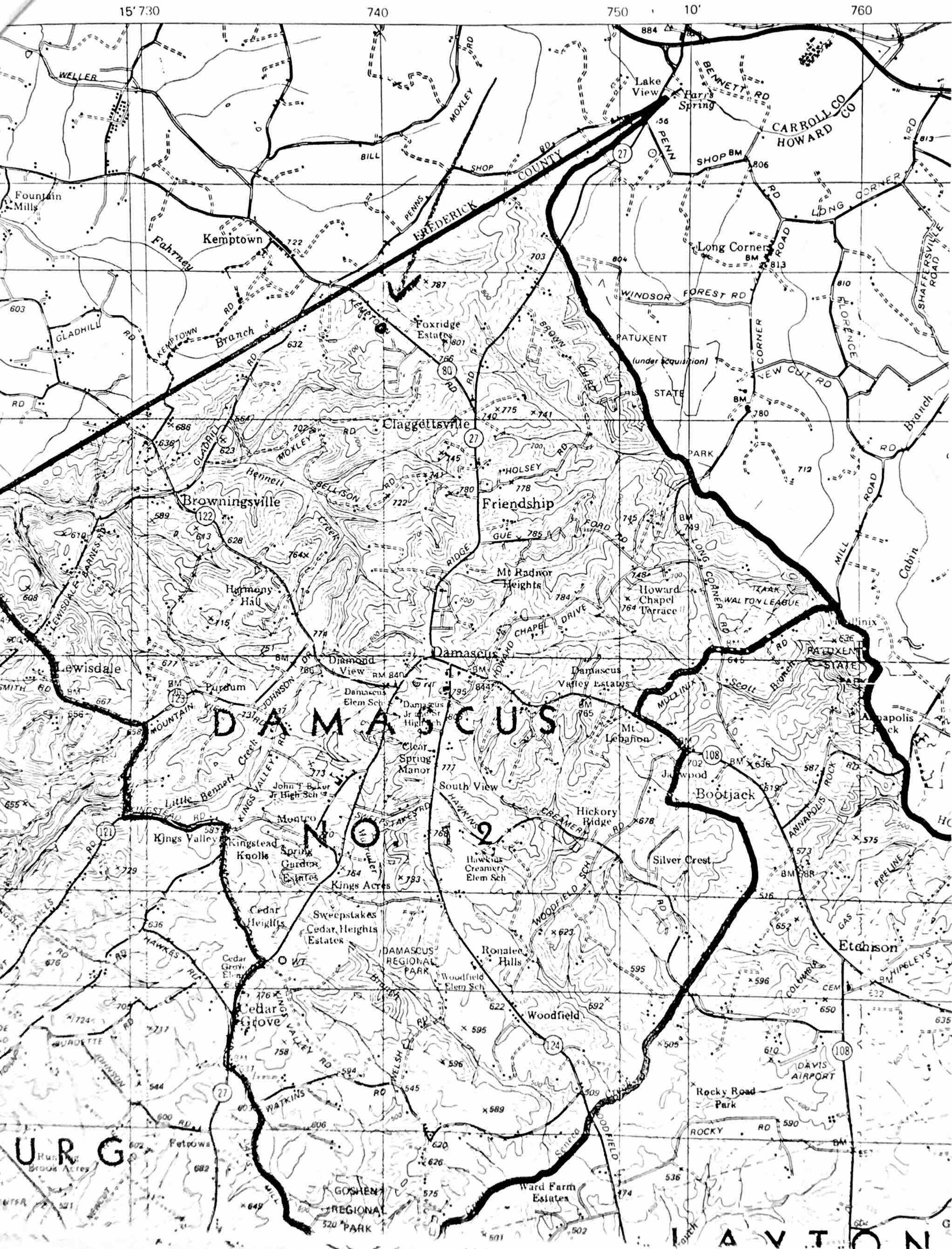

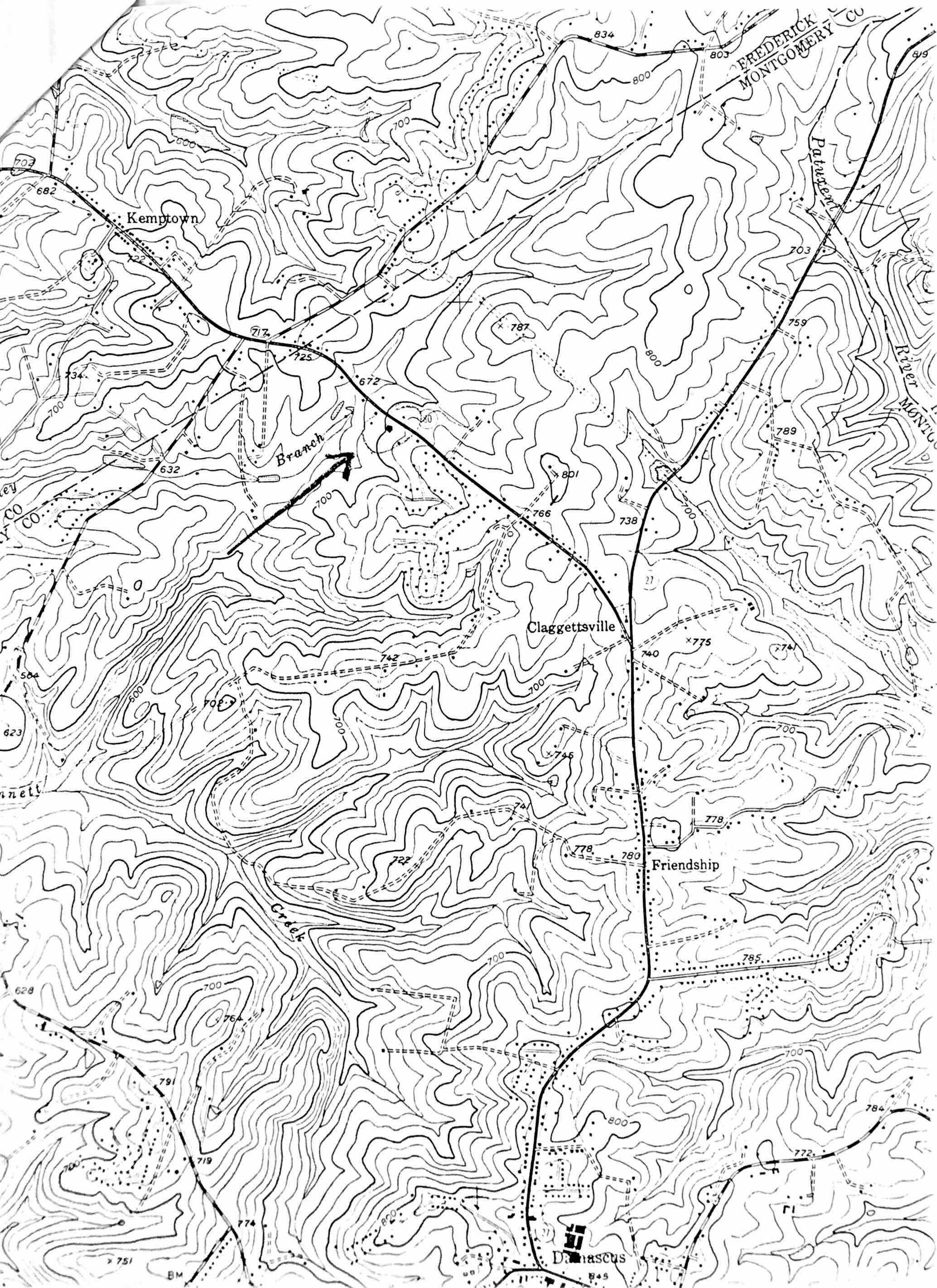
