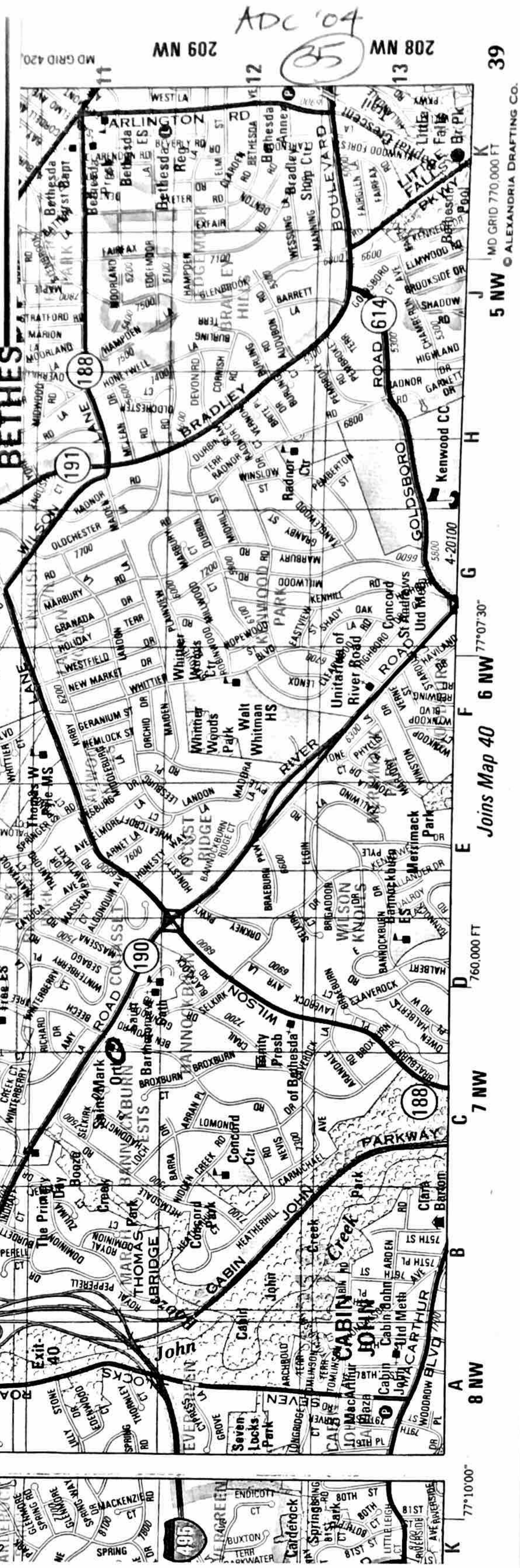

CONCORD METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH CEMETERY AT BETHESDA (ST. MARK ORTHODOX CHURCH, 7124 RIVER ROAD, BETHESDA)

Directions: Concord M.E. Church was located near Cabin John, on road leading to Offutt's Crossroads. [A.D.C. Map: Montgomery, page 38, grid coordinates D-7.] Condition of cemetery: Neglected. Concord established 1851, early records 1856-1900. Inactive cemetery. Earliest known death: 1881. Most recent death: 1954. Cabin John Methodist Episcopal Church built as sister church of Concord M.E. Church in 1920. Date transcribed: 1983. Location of transcribed records: Montgomery County Historical Society Library, 42 West Middle Lane, Rockville, Maryland 20850. Comments: Over 17 marked graves, one volume of records 1920-1937 for Concord and Cabin John M.E. Churches.
