SUSAN w/o Edward Boswell buried on their farm -  
1917

Susan born in Germany came to the country when she was 9 years old, now ate 89, widow of Edward Boswell died Thursday of last week at Ashton, leaving a daughter Mrs Nicholas Miller of Clarksville; 2 sisters Mrs Kent of Harper's Ferry, W. Va., and Mrs Mary Thompson of Highland, Howard Co.; 4 grandchildred and 2 great grandchildren. Funeral - St Louis Catholic Church, Clarksville. Buried - family burying ground on the the Boswell Farm. January 6, 1917

A search of the Montgomery County land records indicates that the farm was at what is now 205 Ashton Road (MD Route 108), Ashton, MD. The current owners, Mattie and Earl Claggett, were contacted and they said that there is on cemetery on that property. The lot is 4 acres and was the only property owned by Susan Boswell at the time of her death.

Neither the will of Edward Boswell (liber HCA 4, folio 260) or Susan (HCA 19, folio 254) specify the description or location of their property. In the 1910 US census, Susan is listed as living on the "Road leading from Ashton to Patuxant River", and an 1878 map of Montgomery County shows their residence beside the Ebenisor AME Church cemetery which joins 205 Ashton Road.

Land records purchases and sales by Edward and Susan are recorded in liber EBP 9 folio 280, EBP 15, folio 453, EBP 12 folio 48, TD6 folio 280, TD 6 folio 236, TD 6 folio 348, and TD 24 folio 26. The estate sale by their daughter Catherine and her husband J. Nicholas Miller is recorded in liber 322 folio 51, dated October 3, 1922. The sale was to Asbury Williams, and the property passed to his daughter Mattie E. in 1937 (liber 675 folio 317). The deed was re-recorded in 1998 and the current deed number is 18199/296. There is no reference to a cemetery in any of the land transfers.

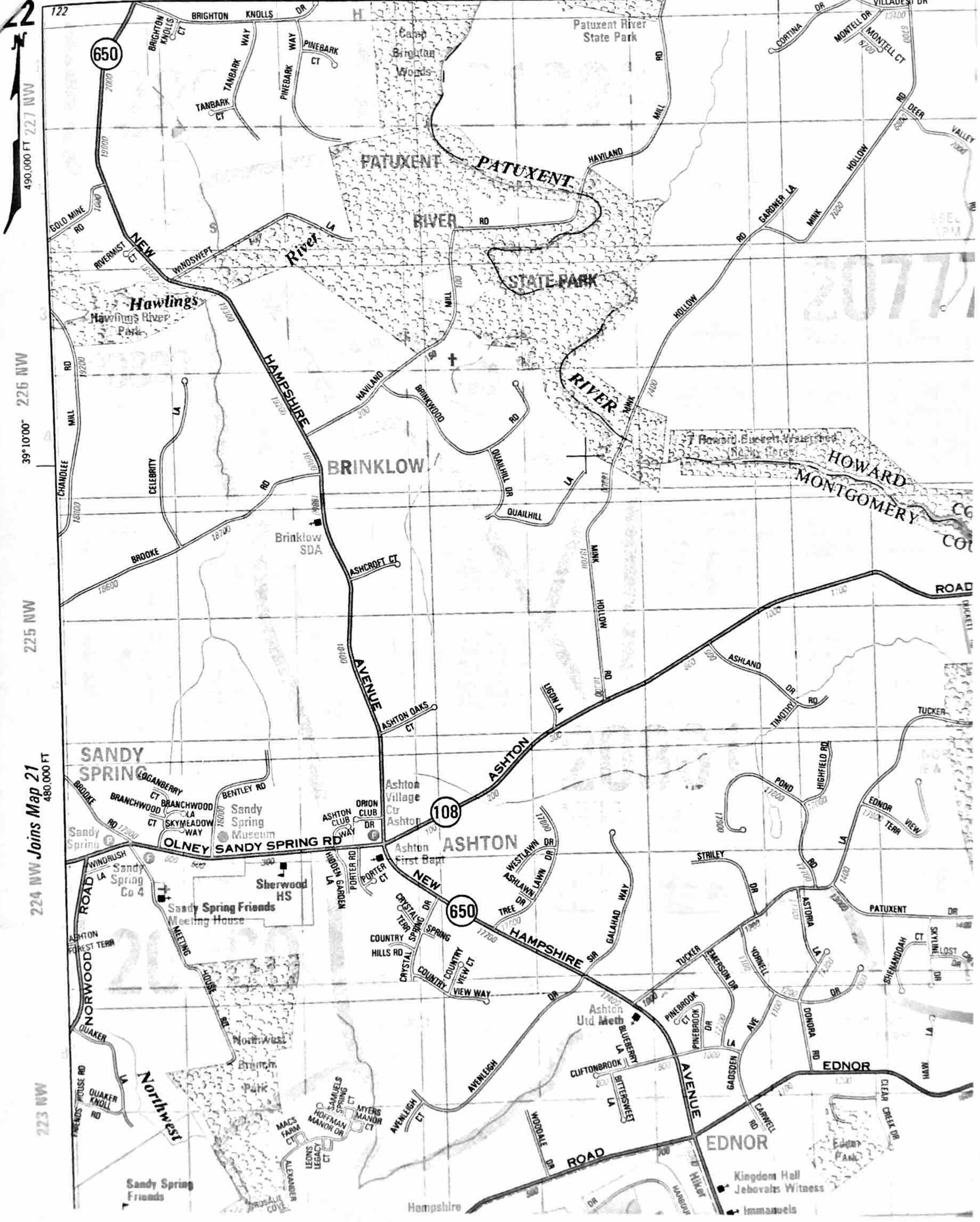
