The tract of land "Mother's Delight" was patented in 1732 by John Crampton for 200 acres. In 1742 he patented another 200 acres as "Addition to Mother's Delight as John Cramphin.

In a deed dated February 28, 1753 and recorded March 20, 1753 THOMAS DAWSON purchased from John Cook of Prince George's County for 100 pounds sterling 200 acres of "Mother's Delight" taken up by John Cramphin and 200 acres of "Addition to Mother's Delight" also taken up by John Cramphin
