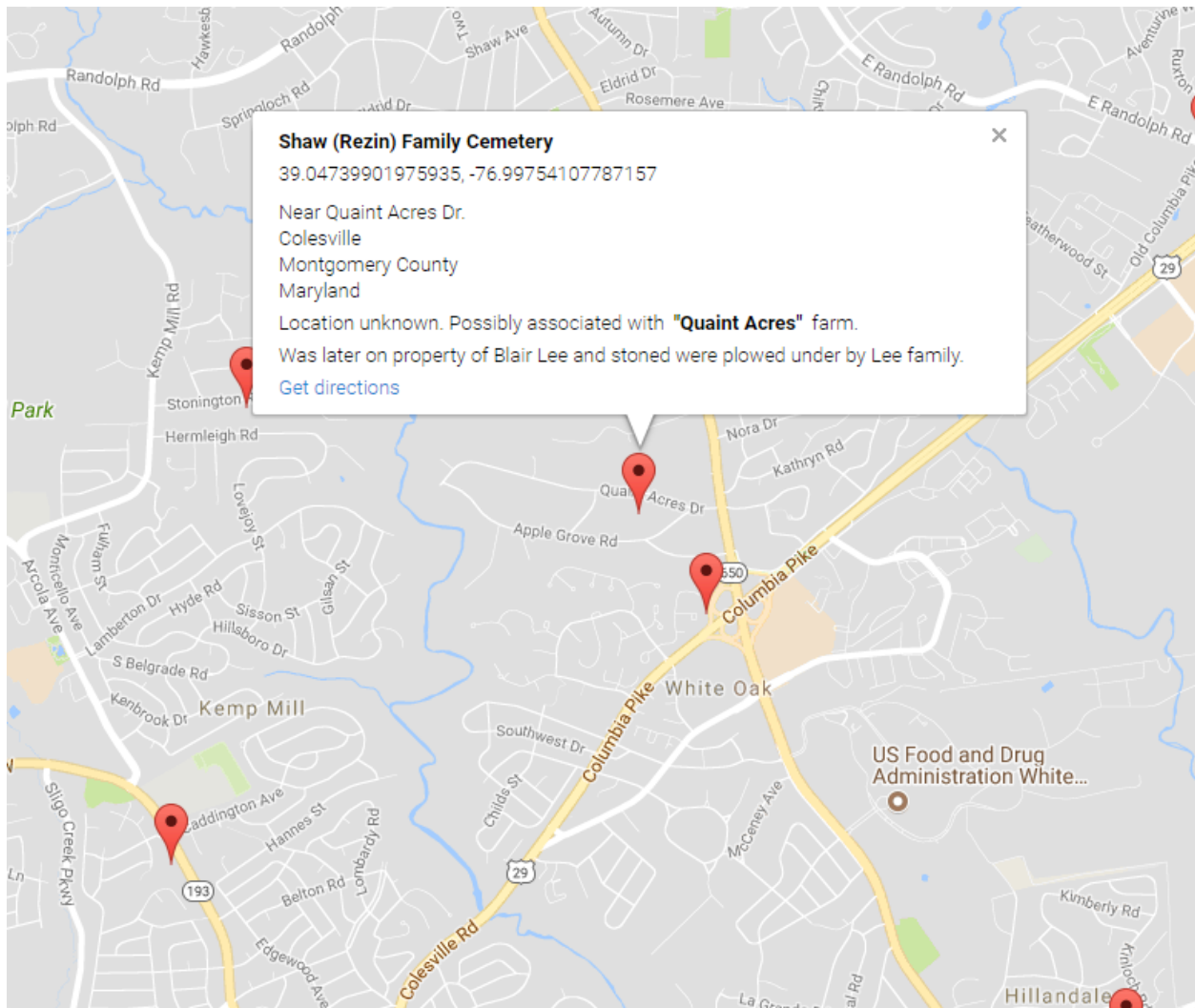

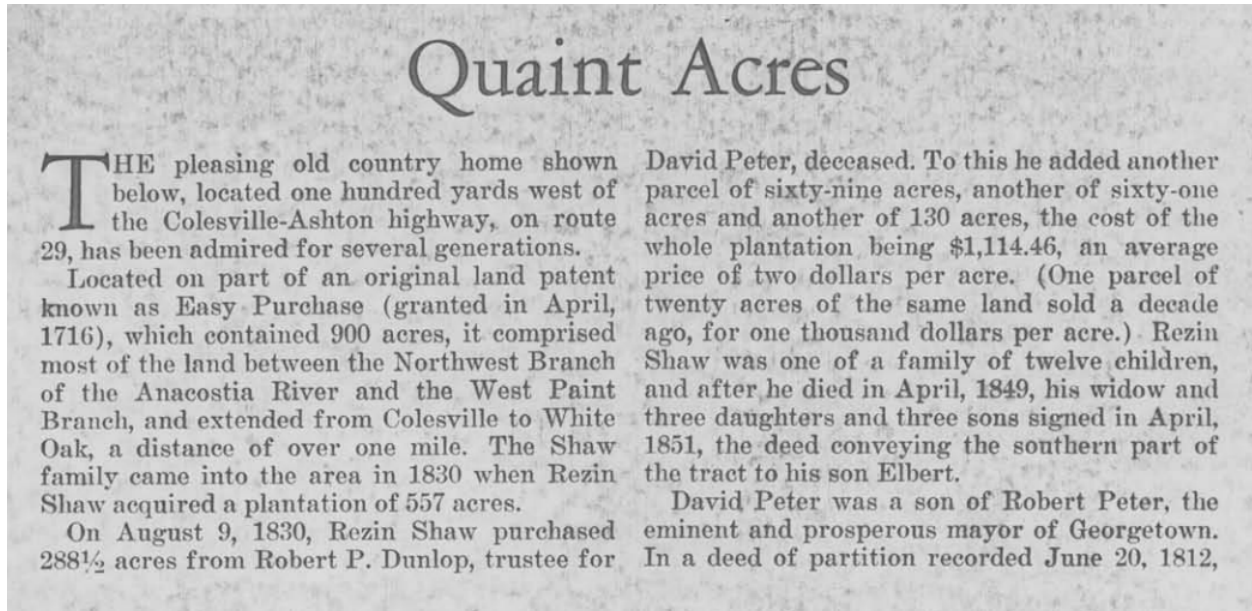
This is a suggested location, but no trace of the cemetery exists.





Also, part of a tract of land called the "Resurvey on the Farm," and part of a tract of land called "the Resurvey on the Grove and Sporting Fields." These two last pieces of land are situated on the Paint Branch, not a far distant from the land now occupied by Mr. Rezin Shaw, and containing about two hundred and thirteen acres of land.
