

Pursuant to an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, the following Bond was recorded the 11th day of May, A.D. 1875, to wit:

Known All Men by These Presents, That we, William A. Veis, Rebecca Veis, Edw. M. Veis, H. F. Veis, & S. Clark Veis, all of Montgomery County, in the State of Maryland, are held and firmly bound unto the said State of Maryland, in the full and just sum of Thirty Two Thousand Dollars, current money, to be paid to the said State of Maryland, or its certain Attorney to which payment well and truly to be made, and do we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this 10th day of May, Eighteen Hundred and seventy five.

Whereas the said William A. Veis hath been duly appointed by the County Commissioners for Montgomery County, a Collector to collect that portion of the assessment or rate imposed by the said County Commissioners upon all the assessable property within the Fourth Election District of said Montgomery County, Maryland.

Now the Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound William A. Veis shall well and faithfully execute his office, and the several duties required of him by law, and shall well and truly account for and pay over to the County Commissioners, or their order, the several sums of money which he shall receive or be answerable for by law at such times as the law shall direct, then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in law.

At the request of Frederick S. Poole, the following Deed was recorded the 11th day of May, A.D. 1875, to wit:

This Deed made this sixteenth day of January, in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy five, by William W. Poole, acting Executor of Thomas Poole, late of Montgomery County, deceased, Witnesseth, Whereas the said Thomas Poole, in his lifetime made and executed a last will and testament which, since his death has been duly admitted to probate and is now on record in the Office of Register of Wills of Montgomery County in the State of Maryland: And whereas by said last will and testament certain lands were directed to be sold, and the said William W. Poole, acting Executor, is aforesaid, together with Thomas W. Poole and Frederick S. Poole, were appointed Executors to make such sale, and what the said Thomas W. Poole & Frederick S. Poole did afterwards by their will- ing and lawful authority of the said Office of R. of Wills authorize and empower the said

William W. Poole to act as sole executor under said last will & testament:

And whereas the said William W. Poole, acting Executor as aforesaid, did on the 10th day of December A.D. 1870 sell a portion of the said land hereinafter more particularly described to Frederick S. Poole of Montgomery County in the State of Maryland at and for the sum of Eight Thousand and Seven Dollars & eighteen & one half cents which said sale was duly reported to the Orphans Court of Montgomery County aforesaid and ratified by said Court and the said Frederick S. Poole has since paid the whole purchase money therefor: Now therefore in consideration of the premises the said William W. Poole, Executor as aforesaid, doth grant unto the said Frederick S. Poole all the following tracts, pieces or parcels of lands, situated & lying in Montgomery County in the State of Maryland being part of a tract of land called "Poole's Right" part of a tract called "Dowden's Luck" part of "Poole's Hayward" two parts of a tract "Aux La Chapelle" and part of a tract called "Chiswell's Inheritance" and described as follows to include the whole: Beginning at a stone standing on the Eastern edge of the Public Road leading from Pikesville to Jounesville and at the end of 13⁷/₂ ps. on a line drawn N. 59° E. from a stone planted near a small branch and marked "Poole's Right Begins Here" and running thence with the East edge of said road N. 12¹/₂° W. 10¹/₂ ps; then N. 69¹/₂° E. 39¹/₁₀ ps to the first line of "Poole's Right" then with said line N. 59° E. 24 ps to the beginning of that part of "Poole's Right" and part of "Clemons' Purchase" conveyed to Walter Poole by John Poole on or about the 22nd day of October A.D. 1813 for about three acres & sixty eight square perches of land then with the lines of said conveyance S. 53° E. 31 ps S. 20¹/₂° E. 10 ps N. 77° E. 4 ps N. 15° W. 7 ps to the beginning of that part of "Poole's Hayward" conveyed to Walter Poole by Joseph Poole Sen. on the 15th day of February A.D. 1806 for about four and one half acres of land, then with the 1st line of said conveyance N. 19¹/₂° E. 35 ps to the 13th line of "Aux La Chapelle" and the beginning of the part of said tract conveyed to Walter Poole by John Poole Jr. A.D. 1809 for about one acre of land, then with the given line of said conveyance reversed N. 15¹/₂° E. 25⁷/₁₀ ps to a stone, then N. 72° E. 14¹/₂ ps to a stone standing at the beginning of that part of "Aux La Chapelle" conveyed to John Poole Jr. by Joseph N. Chiswell on the 23rd day of June A.D. 1813 for about fifty five acres of land; then with said conveyance N. 14° E. 4⁷/₁₀ ps to a stone, N. 1¹/₂° E. 16 ps to a stone, N. 4¹/₂° E. 10 ps to a stone, N. 36° E. 74 ps to a stone, N. 45° E. 30 ps to a stone, N. 55° E. 34 ps to intersect a line of a part of "Aux La Chapelle" conveyed to William Brewer by Joseph N. Chiswell, then with said line reversed S. 67° E. 84 ps to the end of 20 ps on a line drawn S. 72° W. from the stone planted at the beginning of a tract of land called "Mint's Grove"; then with said line so drawn S. 72° W. 5⁷/₁₀ ps to a stone planted at the end of the 2nd line of that part of "Poole's Right" part of "Poole's Hayward" and part of "Aux La Chapelle" conveyed to William Poole by John Poole Jr. on the 2nd day of June A.D. 1821 for about forty five and one half acres of land, then with said conveyance reversed S. 25⁷/₁₀° W. 13⁵/₁₀ ps to a stone, S. 57¹/₁₀° W. 52¹/₁₀ ps to a stone, then with said conveyance

came it being at the end of the 16th line of "Pools Right" then with said tract S. 56^o W. 74^o ps. N. 11^o E. 14^o ps. to a stone; then N. 82^o W. 66^o ps. to the Eastward edge of the road aforesaid; then bounding with the East edge of said road N. 15^o E. 24^o ps. then N. 71^o W. 1^o ps. to a stone on the Western Edge of said road, still N. 71^o W. 17^o ps. to a stone; S. 60^o W. 17^o ps. to a stone; N. 49^o W. 30^o ps. to a stone marked Th. W. C. then N. 65^o W. 6^o ps. to a stone N. 17^o E. 29^o ps. to a stone marked Th. W. C. 130; then E. 20^o ps. to a stone N. 34^o W. 33^o ps. to a stone N. 51^o E. 29^o ps. to the Western edge of the road aforesaid, still N. 81^o E. 2^o ps. to the Eastern edge of said road; then with said road N. 24^o ps. to a stone planted on the Eastern edge thereof; then still with said road N. 13^o W. 27^o ps. to the beginning: Containing two hundred & nineteen & three eighths acres of land, clear of said road and clear of the buying ground, with the right of way to & from the same, described as follows: Beginning at a stone & running thence N. 56^o W. 8^o ps. to a stone N. 22^o E. 6^o ps. to a stone; S. 70^o E. 5^o ps. to a stone; S. 50^o E. 4^o ps. to a stone; S. 49^o W. 3^o ps. to a stone; then S. 27^o W. 4^o ps. to the beginning: Containing sixty two square perches of land the said Buying ground being excepted from this conveyance.

This Deed made this fourth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy four, by Nicholas Brewer and Ruth C. W. Brewer his wife, of Montgomery County, in the State of Maryland Wifelyeth: That in consideration of the payment of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Nicholas Brewer and Ruth C. W. Brewer his wife do grant unto Richard Poole of the said County and State all those parts of tracts of land situate lying and being in the said County of Montgomery, in the
