The Maryland Inventory of Historic Places Form (16-3) reads: "At the time of his death (circa 1807) Thomas Cooley (Cowley) willed his plantation to his wife and seven children. His widow continued to occupy the house until her death in 1825. Her will mentioned a family graveyard on the property." The will reads: "after my debts and funeral charges are paid, and the expence [sic.] of walling the grave yard in with stone and pointed with lime on the insides and out are paid"
