


At the request of The Trustees of the Poor of Montgomery County the following Deed was recorded 12<sup>th</sup> October 1825.  
 This Indenture made this twelfth day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty five between Jesse Leach of Montgomery County and State of Maryland of the one part and the Trustees of the Poor of Montgomery County of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of fourteen hundred dollars to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Jesse Leach hath granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell to the Trustees of the Poor of Montgomery County all that part of a tract or parcel of land situate in Montgomery County aforesaid called and known by the name of "The Wheel of Fortune" or by the name of The Resurvey on the Wheel of Fortune which is included within the courses and lines following to wit: Beginning at a stone marked A now planted on the nineteenth line of a tract of land called The Exchange and New Exchange Enlarged and running thence with the said line South twenty degrees East thirty four perches to a stone marked P.H. N<sup>o</sup> 1. now planted at the end of the tenth line of "The Resurvey on the Wheel of Fortune, then with the lines of said tract reversed South seventy five degrees East sixty five perches and one quarter of a perch to a stone marked P.H. N<sup>o</sup> 2. now planted at the end of the the end of the ninth line of said tract, North fifty seven degrees East forty three perches to a stone marked P.H. N<sup>o</sup> 3. now planted at the end of the eighth line of said tract then North thirty nine perches and one quarter of a perch to a stone marked P.H. N<sup>o</sup> 4. now planted at the end of twenty eight perches on the sixteenth line of "The Exchange and new Exchange Enlarged then South eighty nine degrees West one hundred and thirteen and one half perches to a stone marked P.H. N<sup>o</sup> 5 now planted on the aforesaid nineteenth line of said tract called "The Exchange and New Exchange Enlarged" then with a straight line to the beginning containing thirty three acres of land more or less. To Have and To Hold the said land so as above described with all its rights and appertinances unto the Trustees of The Poor of Montgomery County and their successors forever in fee simple. And the said Jesse Leach, for himself, his heirs and executors doth covenant and agree with the Trustees of the Poor of Montgomery County that he is seized of the said land in his own right in fee simple and that he will warrant and defend the said land with its appertinances unto the Trustees of the Poor of Montgomery County and their successors forever against all persons claiming or that may hereafter claim the same and that he will at all times for the better assuring the lands and premises hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed, make at the proper cost and request of The Trustees of the Poor of Montgomery County such other and further conveyance and assurance as their Counsel learned in the law may advise or they require.
