I, Ezekiel Moxley of Montgomery County in the State of Maryland in consideration of twelve hundred and fifty dollars \$1250<sup>00</sup> paid me by Joseph Wood and Milton Burke do hereby bargain and sell to the said Joseph Wood and Milton Burke the following property, to wit: One black stallion Tom aged 7 years, one brown horse Frank, one sorrel horse John, 2 sorrel mare, 1 pair of oxen one red and white milch cow one black and white buffalaw cow one red heifer 2 years old one buffalaw steer 2 years old red and white crop wheat in the rick crop of oats in rick a lot of potatoes crop of corn in crib crop of Tobacco in the house one sow nine pen hogs, fifteen shoats one four horse wagon one ox cart one spring wagon one carriage, one rockaway buggy one spring wagon one sleigh one set single harness wagon harness all my farming implements also household and kitchen furniture. Also one roan horse (Tiger)
