

Wilson to the Commissioners for the poort; then reversely
 with said conveyance the three following courses and distances
 South eighty six degrees East one hundred and eight
 perches to a stone planted at the end of the first line
 of "Come by Chance"; North forty eight degrees East
 thirty three and one half perches to a stone; North fifty
 five degrees West thirty perches then North eighty six
 and a half degrees East nine and eight tenths perches
 to the end of the 6th line of a conveyance heretofore
 made by David O'Keale to William Jones for 95 acres
 of "The Wheel of Fortune"; then with said conveyance
 the six following courses and distances: Still North
 eighty six and a half degrees East fifty eight perches
 to the end of the 19th line of said tract; then with said
 tract South eighty three degrees East thirty three perches
 to the end of the 4th line of a tract of land called
 "Raymond's Addition" and with it reversed South fifty
 eight degrees East twenty four perches to a stone; then
 leaving the outlines of "The Wheel of Fortune"; South
 thirty seven and a half degrees West sixteen perches
 South thirty one degrees East sixty nine and one tenth
 perches to the end of the 29th line of said tract, and
 the end of the 3rd line of a tract ^{of land} called "Adamson's
 Choice"; then reversely with said third line, still with
 "The Wheel of Fortune"; South nineteen degrees East
 fifty four perches then to include a part of "Partnership
 running with said tract, the three following courses
 and distances. Still nineteen degrees East thirty and a
 half perches to the fifth line of a tract of land called
 "I am Content"; then reversely with said tract; South
 sixty six degrees West eleven perches to the end of the
 4th line of said tract; Still reversely with said tract
 South three degrees West seven perches to the end of
 24 1/2 perches on the 32nd line of "The Wheel of Fortune"
 then reversely with said line North thirty two degrees
 West ten and one half perches to the end of fourteen
 perches on said line; then South eighty four and a
 half degrees West seventy four and three tenths
 perches to the end of the first line of a part of
 "Partnership" conveyed August 29th 1806 by William
 O'Keale Sr. to William O'Keale Jr. for 98 acres then
 with said line reversed South eighty one and a
 half degrees West twenty perches to the beginning
