

The gamily burying ground of Anderson Offutt was located on a farm between Darnestown and Dawsonville. The farm was first patented to Zachariah Offutt for 735 acres in 1785 and named "Petersburgh". The Offutts sold it to the Darby's and it is now owned by Mr. and Mrs. Thompson Butz.

There are a number of \$f\$\psi\psi\psi| graves marked only with feild stones with no inscriptinon. Four with grave stones inscribed are as follows:

Andrew Offutt died January (remainder too obliterated to read)

Eliza Offutt, widow of Andrew Offutt died Jly 12, 1863 (**) age 81 years 28 days

"Our kind sister, Juliet W. Offutt", daughter of Andrew and Eliza Offutt, born November 20, 1815 died July 3, 1866

In memory of our mother Evalina Heall, wige of Horatio Heall died August 18, 1875 age 72 years
