The property, excluding the graveyard and a right of way thereto, was sold at public auction to The Farmers Banking and Trust Company in 1929, and the stone house in which Susan Aud lived was demolished not long after. A tenant, Frank Whisman, lived in a log house on the property from 1936 to 1958.

The present owner bought the property in 1969.

The cemetery is overgrown with weeds and no tombstones are visible. It is about 100 yards south of a barn, near a large maple tree. Most of the tombstones were removed by a tenant when the farm was sold in 1929. A former tenant stated there were two graveyards -- one for the family and one for slaves. The family cemetery was near the barn, and the slave cemetery was near a "hogpen".

The tombstones were of Seneca sandstone. In 1973, only one stone could be located, dated 1818; it may have been the first child of Asa and Catherine Aud, who died in infancy.

A small stone house, log house, stable and other outbuildings once stood on the farm. The stone house was torn down about the time the tombstones were removed, b and the log house was demolished in the 1960s. The stone house was $1\frac{1}{2}$ stories high, with 5-6 rooms and a shingle roof. A barn and four sheds (all in poor repair) remain.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This cemetery serves as a reminder of at least two generations of the Aud family which lived on and farmed this land.

The cemetery dates back to 1818 and possibly further. It was used by the Auds and possibly the Hickmans as a family burial ground. Slaves were apparently buried here also, possibly in a separate graveyard.

Asa Aud (1790-1860) was born near Buckeystown, Frederick County. He enlisted in the War of 1812, and married Catherine Hickman of Poolesville in 1817.

In 1826, Asa and Catherine moved from Virginia onto the farm (the subject property) of her father, William Hickman.

Gary Aud, Asa's son, was deeded a share of the farm in 1860, by Gary Hickman. The last surviving child of Asa and Catherine, Susan Aud, remained on the farm until her death in 1916, and was the last known burial in the graveyard.

The property, excluding the graveyard and a right of way thereto, was sold at public auction to The Farmers Banking and Trust Company in 1929, and the stone house in which Susan Aud lived was demolished not long after. A tenant, Frank Whisman, lived in a log house on the property from 1936 to 1958.

The present owner bought the property in 1969.

The cemetery is completely overgrown, and rests in a sapling thicket about 40 yards SE of the present trailer. Only part of one tombstone is visible, and this is a Seneca sandstone marker that reads in part "departed...June 1818 (or 1819)..." There is another marked stone that appears to be a boundary marker. According to the present tenant, who has lived here for several years, there was an old log house here that burned during the 1960's, about Christmas Day. According to the Aud family, there was a stone house here that was demolished.


