The cemetery is on the east side of Frederick Road (MD Rte 355) approximately 1/2 miles south of the church. There are not signs to identify the cemetery. Hyansiown Christian Chair

The markers are mostly upright stones, with a few ground level bronze markers. The cemetery is laid out in north-south rows and there are no roads or paths thru the cemetery. The older stones are moss covered or blackened by age. The older stones appear to be sandstone, and the later ones are granite or marble. side of road

The cemetery is fenced only on the west side by a chain link fence, with a single gate for admission. The north and east sides boundaries are the Bennett Creek. The south side is not fenced but is separated from MD 355 by trees and a guardrail.
