He bought 200 acres of land on the Pawtuxant River from John Dorsey and later added an additional 1300 acres. He married a Miss Hobbs who died without children, then remarried Jane Perry who produced 11 children. I am sure other Gartrells were buried in the graveyard also.

Dorcus Gartrell, b. 1724 d. abt 1784 - a daughter of Francis, Sr. married a sea captain named Matthew Pigman and they had a son named Nathan and he or some of his decendants are said to be buried in the family graveyard.
