SIGNIFICANCE NATIONAL REGISTER CRITERIA: A X B C D The Washington Aqueduct is listed as a Registered National Historical Landmark (9/08/73, A,C, NHL, 73002123). Constructed between 1853 and 1863, the aqueduct was designed by Montgomery C. Meigs (1816-1892), a distinguished engineer under the auspices of the Army Corps of Engineers. In 1853, Congress appropriated money to begin the construction process; 300 to 400 laborers were employed for work through the winter and following spring. By 1854, three water tunnels were begun and a quarry at Seneca, MD, had been purchased and opened to supply the cut stone needed for the culverts, gate house, and bridges. Work on the aqueduct continued intermittently until its completion in 1863. The cemetery near the Great Falls entrance was previously located on land owned by the Army Corps of Engineers before it was acquired by the National Park Service. This land lies adjacent to the old "Conduit Road" now referred to as MacArthur Boulevard and initially constructed to gain access to the Washington Aqueduct. Conduit Road was completed in 1875; previous access was gained by the "Rockville Road" which led from Great Falls to Rockville, MD. Primary evidence of the association between the cemetery and the aqueduct was acquired through the inscription on the largest stone which indicated that the deceased (Matthew Rayner) was a "stone cutter" who died at age 25 years in 1855. The date of death, profession of the deceased, and location of the cemetery indicate that the cemetery is related to the construction of the Washington Aqueduct. Another stone dated "1861" confirms the period of activity for the cemetery. The eleven stones in the cemetery are most likely those of workers on the aqueduct, exact cause of death unknown. The Rayner headstone is a contribution greature as it dates from the historic construction period and derives its primary significance from association with

DESCRIPTION The cemetery is located approx. 20' N of MacArthur Blvd. and approx. 1/8 mile E of the Great Falls entrance station near the parking lot. At least 10 stones have been located, only three of which retain identifying markings (see attached map). Stone 1 is the largest and is a sandstone marker approx. 3' tall, 15" across and 5" thick. The stone is finely carved with lettering as follows: "Sacred to/The Memory of/Matthew Rayner/Stone cutter of Pudsey/Yorkshire England/who died July 13 1855/ Aged 25 years." He may have worked on the Intake Control Gate House, constructed of carved sandstone, located nearby and begun in 1853. Stone 4 is crudely lettered on a rough fieldstone "D H/L". Stone 9 is also an uncarved fieldstone with two surfaces angling away from each other; the letters "T.OR." and the date "1861" are crudely carved. The remaining stones are undistinguished fieldstones, placed intermittently within an area measuring approx. 45' x 20'. Some of the stone may be paired as head and foot stones, others may signify only a headstone.
