MPI Volunteer recorded directions: "Go 1/10-mile from road, turn right at red barn and water spigot. Follow grass path. Turn left at second spigot. Graves are in grove of trees; 13 headstones and 7 field stone markers; Concrete circle pads once held fence posts."

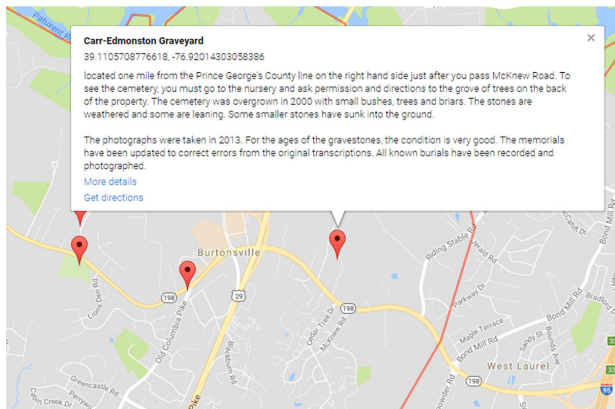

There are approximately 30 fieldstones and stones within the area of the other tombstones. There appear to be concrete circles which once held fence posts. Only the broken concrete circles remain. This was once the property of the Carr family. Sarah Burton was a Carr and married Isaac Burton. Mary Elizabeth Carr was an Iglehart. Isabella Iglehart was a Carr. (Part of the research done by Mrs. D.E. Lord of Burtonsville, MD).

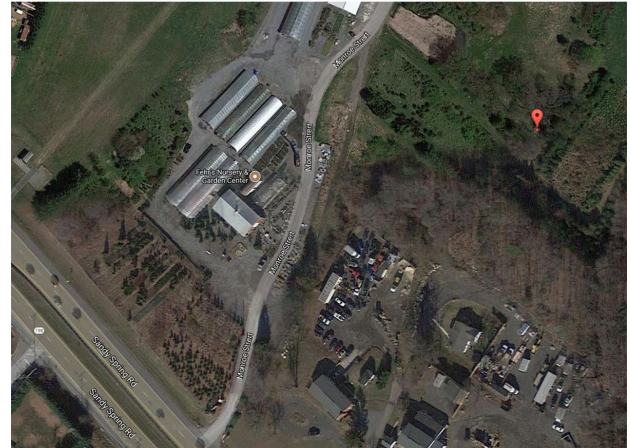
