The above-referenced proposal has been received and reviewed. Your proposal is to demolish the brick parapet at the commercial building at 7216 Carroll Avenue and install a new parapet matching the dimensions, size, materials, and finish.

It is my opinion that this project does **not** constitute a substantial alteration to the historic resource and is an **in-kind** replacement. Therefore, I find that no further review under the Montgomery County historic preservation ordinance (Chapter 24A-10) is warranted. A Historic Area Work Permit (HAWP) is not necessary, unless changes are made to the current plans. Please secure all necessary building permits from the Department of Permitting Services.
