SUBJECT: Historic Area Work Permit # 823721: Building addition, accessory structure demo/construction

The Montgomery County Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) has reviewed the attached application for a Historic Area Work Permit (HAWP). This application was **Approved with three (3) conditions** at the January 23, 2017 Historic Preservation Commission meeting.

Conditions:

- 1. The first floor must have stacked windows on the east side of the addition;
- 2. The windows in the addition on the west façade must be stacked; and
- 3. The lower gable on the rear of the addition must be converted to a shed roof.

The HPC staff has reviewed the drawings and determined that they satisfy the conditions and has stamped the attached construction drawings.

THE BUILDING PERMIT FOR THIS PROJECT SHALL BE ISSUED CONDITIONAL UPON ADHERENCE TO THE ABOVE APPROVED HAWP CONDITIONS AND MAY REQUIRE APPROVAL BY DPS OR ANOTHER LOCAL OFFICE BEFORE WORK CAN BEGIN.
