HORIZONTAL CEDAR FENCE

Cedar Horizontal Fence Proposal

- **Materials:

- Premium **Western Red Cedar** (naturally rot-resistant).
- **Horizontal slats** (1x6 or 1x4, spaced evenly).
- **4x4 cedar posts** (set in concrete for stability).
- **6x6 cedar gate posts** (reinforced for heavy-duty gate).
- **3-rail frame** (2x4 cedar for added strength).
- **6' wide matching cedar gate** (anti-sag cross-bracing included).
- **Black powder-coated hardware** (hinges, latch, screws).






