PROPOSAL: INSTALL SECURITY DOORS RECOMMEND: Approval w/

condition

The applicant proposes to install a security/storm door in a double door opening at the entrance of 3730 Howard Avenue and in a single door opening at 3734. This application is before the Commission due to recent crime experienced by the applicant at the property addresses. The properties are secondary resources located within the commercial area of the Kensington Historic District.

As proposed, the security/storm doors would be visible from the streetscape. The applicant does not propose removal of the existing doors.

STAFF DISCUSSION

The applicant requests HPC approval to install security/storm doors within the existing openings. The existing doors will not be removed. The new storm doors would be installed over the existing doors and as such the new doors would be very visible from the streetscape.

Staff recommends that the new door grillwork be simplified so as not to include additional fretwork. That is, staff recommends approval of this application to protect the resource, provided that the ironwork be painted black and constructed of simple vertical and horizontal bars without fretwork.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

With the following condition, staff recommends that the Commission find the proposal consistent with the purposes of Chapter 24A-8(b)3:

The proposal would enhance or aid in the protection, preservation and public or private utilization of the historic site, or historic resource located within an historic district, in a

manner compatible with the historical, archeological, architectural or cultural value of the historic site or historic district in which an historic resource is located;

and with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation #2 and #10:

The historic character of a property shall be retained and preserved. The removal of historic materials or alteration of features and spaces that characterize a property shall be avoided; and

New additions and adjacent or related new construction shall be undertaken in such a manner that if removed in the future, the essential form and integrity of the historic property and its environment would be unimpaired.

Condition:

1. Ironwork of the security door shall be painted black and simplified;

and with the following general condition:

The applicant shall notify the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) five days prior to commencing work and within two weeks after completion.






