FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- 1. The above property is located within the Boyds Historic District (#18/8 on the Master Plan for Historic Preservation in Montgomery County), and is a contributing resource thereto;
- 2. The applicant filed an application for work to be done on the fellowship hall at above referenced address on April 21, 1988;
- 3. The application was the subject of a duly advertised public hearing before the Historic Preservation Commission on May 5, 1988;
- 4. The following items were approved, with conditions as noted, based on criterion 24A-8 (b)(3) of the Montgomery County Code;
 - a. The roof may be replaced with asphalt shingles to be silver cloud in color;
 - Existing windows may be replaced with new wood thermopane windows;
 - Exterior white-frame aluminum or wood window screens may be installed;
 - A rear entrance deck of style to be determined may be constructed;
- 5. The application to install aluminum sidings on the fellowship hall was denied because it was found that it would substantially alter the exterior features of the historic site and is incompatable in character and nature with the architectural features of the historic site.
- 6. The record remained open on all other items of the application including the following: Construction of a front/side porch and attendant work including replacement of two existing windows with doors, installation of a handicap access ramp, and replacement of the front door.
