PROPOSAL: Construct front porch RECOMMEND: Proceed

The applicant proposes the reconstruction of a front porch on a contributing resource in the Takoma Park Historic District. The original porch was removed and only the flooring remains.

The applicant would rebuild the porch in the Colonial Revival style, using dimensions indicated by the porch floor and elements surviving on the front facade. The porch would have a balustrade around the roof since there is a second story door. Lattice would be used between the piers below the porch.

In addition, new double-hung wood sash windows would be installed in existing openings at the rear enclosed porch, and a new chimney with a pebble-dash stucco finish would be added to the left gable face of the house. The profile of the new chimney would match that of the existing.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION


The proportions of the columns, the posts of the balustrade, and the square pickets are typical of Colonial Revival details on houses of that period in the historic district. The new windows at the rear could be either multi-paned or 1/1 sash.

The staff encourages the applicant to proceed with the scheme and notes that the work appears to be eligible for the county's historic preservation tax credit since missing features of the house would be replaced.


Dear Nancy,



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FRONT ELEVATION


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
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


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SIDE ELEVATION
